#### **METHODOLOGY**


The survey was conducted online and included two population:

- 1,480 interviewees were current Masa Israel Journey participants and alumni from around the world.
- 503 interviewees were native Israelis, a representative sample of Israel's Hebrew speaking population



After returning home to your country of origin, will you work to improve Israel's image in the world?


- Intend to act to improve Israel's image

- Do not intend to act to improve Israel's image






#### HOW: ACTIONS TO IMPROVE ISRAEL'S IMAGE

Those who answered "I'm sure I will / I do" or "I think so" were asked: What steps are you prepared to take to fight anti-Israel activism back home?











#### 81% OF PARTICIPANTS VIEW ISRAEL MORE POSITIVELY AFTER A MASA PROGRAM

Perception of Israel following participation in Masa




Israel's image in the world compared to reality

I will recommend to my friends and family to visit Israel


I intend to visit Israel in the future

In your opinion, what is the most effective way to strengthen the relationship between Israel and Diaspora Jews?








#### **BUSINESS CONNECTIONS** IN ISRAEL

Will you make an effort to maintain or expand them?














### 94%: STRENGTHENING CONNECTION WITH DIASPORA JEWRY IS VITAL FOR ISRAEL'S STRENGTH

The importance of strengthening the connection with Diaspora Jewry to Israel's strength


The importance of reducing the number of assimilation as a result of a stay in Israel within the framework of Masa

In your opinion, would the investment of money by the Government in bringing young Jews to experience an extended period of life in Israel be justified or would it not be justified?








### THE MASA EXPERIENCE AS A REFLECTION OF THE REALITY IN ISRAEL

How far, in your opinion, does staying for a period of time in Israel within the framework of a project such as "Masa" reflect or not reflect the reality in Israel to the participants?







Participants found the security situation far less disturbing than assumed.
